Day-by-Day in Detail

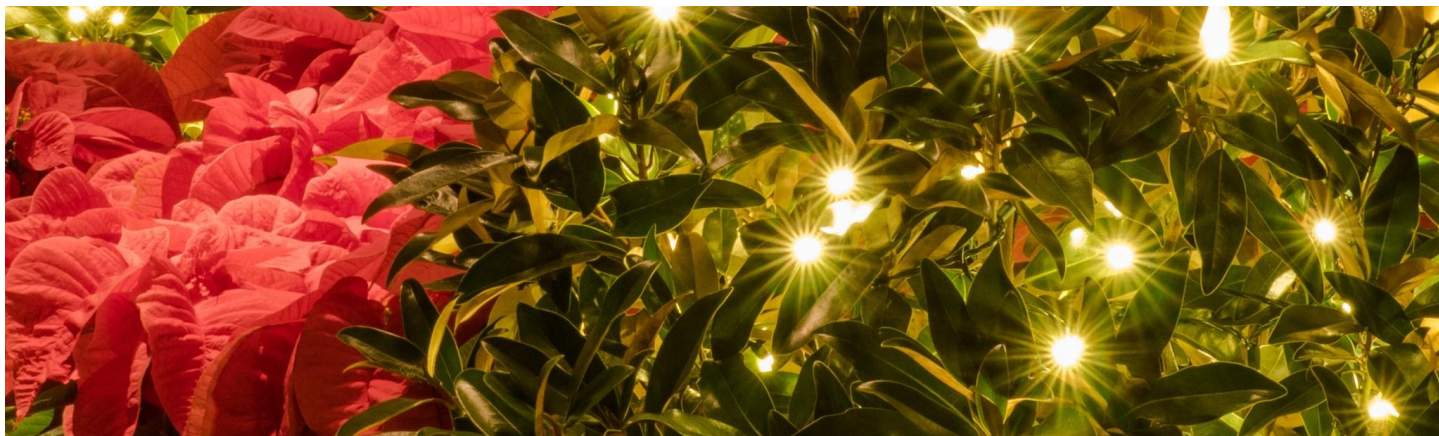
Saturday, November 30th - Today, we will travel to Asheville, NC via motor coach. Upon arrival, we will check into our hotel before heading to Aldridge Hall for a Welcome BBQ Dinner including live Bluegrass Music!

Sunday, December 1st - After breakfast, depart for the Omni Grove Park Inn. This historic hotel has been home to the National Gingerbread Exhibit since 1992, which has grown into one of the nation's most celebrated & competitive holiday events. Following time to browse the designs, continue to Mast's General Store. Built in 1882, the site has been named to the National Register of Historic Places, as one of the last & finest examples of an old country general store. Lunch will be on your own in downtown Asheville before boarding the Holly Jolly Christmas Trolley, an entertaining blend of holiday storytelling and traditional Christmas caroling. This afternoon, arrive at the Biltmore Estate - Completed in 1885, George Vanderbilt's 250-room French château is a real-life wonder, and is even more so during the holiday season. Antler Hill Village & Winery connects the estate's past and present, providing a relaxing place for shopping, historical exhibits, & Biltmore's exceptional hospitality. During this time, you are also able to explore the estate's gardens & grounds at leisure. This evening, enjoy a delicious candlelight dinner at Stable Café, located on Biltmore grounds, followed by a self-guided (audio) tour of the Biltmore Estate's Candlelight Christmas. A majestic Norway Spruce and pathway luminaries welcome you to America's Largest Home[®]. Inside, Christmas music plays while thousands of ornaments reflect the glow of soft candles, fireplaces, and twinkle lights. There are more than 100 hand-decorated trees, 100,000 holiday lights, 1,200 live poinsettias and 6,000ft of fresh Evergreen garland provide the Estate with a magical ambiance.

Monday, December 2nd - Following breakfast, we will check out of the hotel and continue to Pigeon Forge, TN, arriving at Dollywood Park this morning. Your admission ticket includes exciting attractions, award-winning shows, culinary delights (the Cinnamon Bread at The Grist Mill is a MUST!), and seasonal shopping. Take a break from the excitement and check-in to Dolly Parton's DreamMore Resort for a 2-night stay before returning to the park for Dollywood's Smoky Mountain Christmas - The spirit of the season shines brightest during Smoky Mountain Christmas, voted America's Best Christmas Event for more than a decade. Here, the skies dance with the glimmer of more than 6 million twinkling lights, the sounds of award-winning shows fill the air with Christmas cheer, and memories are made beneath star-lit mountain skies.

Tuesday, December 3rd - After enjoying breakfast, head out to The Island (Pigeon Forge's premier entertainment district) & take a ride on the Great Smoky Mountain Wheel. Then, tour Ole Smoky[®] Tennessee Moonshine distillery. The rest of the afternoon will be at your leisure to explore The Island's many shops, restaurants, and attractions. This evening, return to DreamMore Resort for dinner on your own - or - join us for an *optional* Christmas-themed dinner show at Dolly Parton's Stampede (\$75 per person)

Wednesday, December 4rd - This morning, following breakfast, we will check-out of our hotel. Before heading home, stop at TITANIC Museum Pigeon Forge and enjoy Christmastime at Titanic - The beauty & charm of a once-upon-a-time Edwardian Christmas will dazzle & amaze with twinkling lights, lush garlands, wreaths and towering Christmas trees.
