Day-by-Day in Detail

<u>Thursday, August 8th</u> - Today, we will travel via deluxe motor coach to Elkins, WV. En Route, we will make a stop in Arthurdale - Revisit the 1930s in Arthurdale, West Virginia. Established in 1933, by the United States government, Arthurdale is the nation's first New Deal Homestead Community. Created through President Franklin D. Roosevelt's New Deal legislation, the community provided a new chance at life for residents of West Virginia who were suffering from the Great Depression. First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt served as the empathetic force behind the community, which became known as "Eleanor's Little Village" because of her interest. Today, Arthurdale is a National Historic District that features 160 of 165 original homesteads. After our tour, a box lunch will be provided.

Upon arrival in Elkins, we will check-in to our hotel for a 2-night stay. Tonight, we will enjoy a delicious Welcome Dinner at the Gandy Dancer Theatre.

Friday, August 9th - Following breakfast, we will depart for Cass Scenic Railroad. Embarking on the Bald Knob route, the long haul to Bald Knob takes about 4 ½ hours for the 22-mile round trip. Panoramas of the lofty Appalachians become more beautiful as the train climbs higher and higher. Passengers suddenly realize they are entering a completely different world, mainly because of the change in trees, flowers and atmosphere. Due to the increase in altitude (climbing 2,390 feet from Cass to Bald Knob), passengers will have made the equivalent to an 800-mile trip to Canada in climate. Here are found spruce trees, snowshoe hares and other plants and animals typical in the far north. The rustic overlook affords one of the most awesome, overwhelming spectacles in the east. Dwarfed by distance and almost lost in the vastness of the panorama, is the giant Robert C. Byrd Green Bank Telescope, the world's largest fully steerable radio telescope, at the Green Bank Observatory in the valley near the foot of the mountain. A remarkable contrast between the wilderness at Bald Knob and today's space-age facilities! A "King of the Road" hobo lunch will be provided to enjoy with your ride, as well. The hobo lunch consists of a cold sandwich (lunch meat, cheese, etc. all separated in plastic wrap), chips, cookie, and bottled water. A ride on the Cass Scenic Railroad is an unforgettable experience.

Returning to Elkins this afternoon, then dinner at a local restaurant this evening will end the day.

<u>Saturday, August 10</u>th - This morning, enjoy breakfast before checking out of our hotel and heading to the West Virginia Railroad Museum. Peruse at your leisure during a self-guided tour of the museum. Then, we will depart aboard the New Tygart Flyer. This wilderness excursion features mountain grades, an "S" curve tunnel, a high bridge and miles of unspoiled mountain views. Vintage diesel-powered locomotives climb along the cascading Shavers Fork of the Cheat River to the High Falls of Cheat. On the trip to the Falls, enjoy a cold cut lunch, which is included. The trip culminates at the High Falls of Cheat, an 18' high, 150' wide waterfall located in one of the most remote and pristine settings in the region. If you're looking for comfort and spectacular views on a vintage train this is the ride for you! *Please Note: New Tygart Flyer is not wheelchair/handicap accessible.*

Departing for Columbus this afternoon, we will arrive this evening (meal & rest stops made en route).
